American Court Services' proprietary web application, the Substance Abuse Monitoring Services Online Network, or *i-samson.net*, was introduced to criminal justice and treatment communities in 2006 and manages the selection of clients required to submit to random drug and alcohol testing. *i-samson.net* automatically selects and notifies clients for drug and alcohol testing, and provides test results and compliance reports via email to supervising officers, caseworkers and clinicians.

An evidence-based design allows you to set the frequency of testing for each of your clients based on risk level, court order, assessment, proximal / distal behaviors or other collaborative information.


Each client is selected on an individual and truly random basis, so they never know from one day to the next whether or not they will be selected.

The HIPAA-compliant Message Center allows authorized agencies to view test results and share critical information across a secure web portal. *i-samson.net* provides customizable reports to inform program staff and supervising officers about missed calls, missed tests and positive results.



VIEW YOUR CLIENT'S TESTING HISTORY WITH JUST A COUPLE CLICKS OF A MOUSE

The Overall Report allows authorized agencies to compress reports into a specific date range, or show only certain types of information. Test results that are listed in the Overall Report are hyperlinked to direct users to detailed test result information. Overall reports are printable for use in client meetings or court proceedings.

UTILIZE AUTOMATED STATISTICS FOR FISCAL REPORTS OR GRANT OPPORTUNITIES

The *Info Center* allows program staff to create caseload-specific or agencywide aggregate statistical data to track test results and trends that reflect the most commonly abused drugs or to analyze the effectiveness of their random testing program.
